Partner Assault Response (PAR) Program: Intake Information

INTRODUCTION TO THE PAR PROGRAM

Our PAR (Partner Assault Response) Program is for clients who want to help end their violent, abusive and controlling behaviours. Groups run for 16 weeks and are available in Brampton, Mississauga and Orangeville. In this group clients can:

- Talk to others in a supportive environment
- Understand why they act abusively
- Develop more effective and non abusive relationship skills
- Take responsibility for their unhealthy behaviours

PAR is offered for men in a group setting. Groups are co-facilitated by a male and female team. There can be anywhere from 10 – 20 clients in a group.

PAR is offered for women through one to one counseling.

DOCUMENTS TO BRING

In order to complete the intake and enroll you in the PAR program please bring all your applicable documents from the list below:

- Proof of legal name.
- Proof of current address
- Copy of probation order or other court document that outlines the charges and / requirements.

YOU WILL ALSO BE ASKED TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

Name of collateral contacts (Probation Officer, Crown Attorney, CAS Worker, etc. Ontario Works or ODSP caseworker).

Name and contact information of the person harmed, your current partner, your former partner and/or other relevant people.

Please remember that the more information you provide at intake, the sooner you will be fully registered and can begin the program.

THE INTAKE SESSION

The intake session is a one-hour meeting with CFSPD staff and involves asking questions about your situation, assessing your needs, giving you information about the program and explaining the process of your involvement with PAR.

AFTER THE INTAKE

You will be contacted by our office and given a start date.

A letter will also be faxed to your mandating source (Parole/Probation Officer, Crown attorney, etc) confirming your status with the program and throughout your enrollment.

FEES

\$35.00 per session for the intake as well as for each session you attend.

If you are on OW or ODSP, this agency will write to them on your behalf for payment of the session fees.

Payment is due each time you attend Full payment is required before a completion letter will be sent out.

EXPECTATIONS OF YOU DURING GROUP

- Attending the full 2 hours.
- Participating in group.
- Being punctual. Clients who arrive after the door is locked are considered to have missed the group.
- Payment of the fees.

PROGRAM COMPLETION

Completion occurs when you have attended the 16 sessions. You are allowed to miss two sessions but you must make them up.

If you miss a 3rd session, you will be withdrawn from group.

A completion letter will be sent out to the relevant parties once you have completed the 16 sessions and paid all fees.
