Referrals

We accept clients referred through the judicial system (court, crown, probation), Children's Aid Society or referrals direct from clients interested in attending for their own purposes.

Intake

The intake session is a one-hour meeting with a Caseworker and involves asking questions about your situation, assessing your needs, giving you information about the program and explaining the process of your involvement with PAR.

In Peel Region, please attend the office in Brampton, 60 West Drive., Suite 201 on any Monday (with the exception of holidays) between 9am and 7:30pm to complete your intake.

No appointment needed.

Please bring photo identification and all legal documents.

If you require an interpreter for your intake, please call 905 450-1608 x 112 to arrange for one.

In Dufferin County, please call 905 450-1608 x 112 to schedule your intake.

About our Program

In Peel Region, Catholic Family Services is one of three agencies offering the PAR program.

We offer 5 men's groups in Peel and one in Dufferin County (Orangeville).

What to Expect

The groups are open which means that men can start whenever space is available and finish after completing 12 sessions.

There is a \$35 fee for the intake and each session. Financial subsidy available for those who qualify.

Please enquire at your intake session about financial eligibility .

In this group you can:

- Talk to others in a supportive environment
- Understand why you act abusively
- Develop more effective relationship skills
- Take responsibility for your behaviours

Groups are co-facilitated by a male and female facilitators. They have approx. 15-18 men in them at all times.

Members are encouraged to share/challenge/support one another in this safe environment. Consider areas of your life that you may want to change/improve/focus .

South Asian Group:

In partnership with India Rainbow Community Services, this group operates simultaneously in **Punjabi, Hindi and Urdu.**

The program addresses cultural themes and makes use of culturally relevant materials and media to explore the understanding of violence in intimate relationships.
